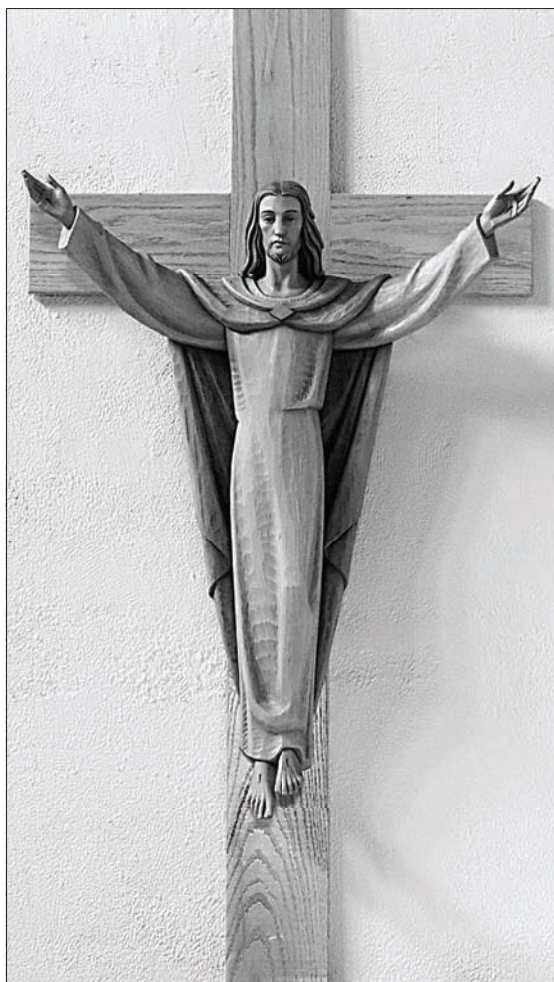

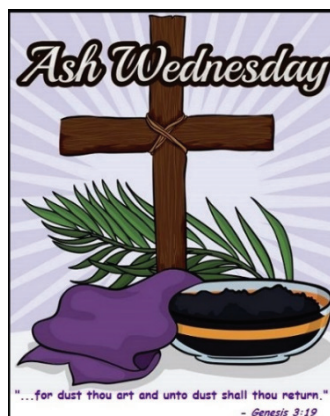

Growing in Stewardship and Holiness

God says toll of us “be holy, for I am the Lord your God am holy.” The Second Vatican Council teaches us that we can reach holiness by gratefully acknowledging the gifts God has given us and cooperating with God in giving these gifts back for the service of the Church. Therefore, let us take some time to reflect on how we can become better stewards in our parish community so that we may move closer, through God's grace, towards holiness.

Ministry Recognition Weekend

As part of our parish commitment to stewardship, we will recognize one of our parish ministries on the first Sunday of each month. We want to acknowledge the commitment to service that people in our parish share with us in such a variety of ways. Each month, we will highlight a ministry with a bulletin announcement, a brief description of the work of the ministry and a presentation from someone of the ministry to the parish community.

Each of us has been blessed with gifts from God, and we will celebrate the way that so many in our parish share those gifts with us. This will also provide an opportunity for each ministry to invite fellow parishioners to ask how they can become more involved in our parish life.

The weekend of February 29/March 1st our parish will recognize two ministries, the Extraordinary Minister of Communion and the Extraordinary Minister of Communion to the Sick and Homebound.

The Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion serves the Eucharistic life of the community by assisting the Ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist (bishops, priests, and deacons) during the Communion Rite. There is a team of parishioners who carry out this ministry in our parish at the Masses.

The Extraordinary Minister of Communion to the Sick and Homebound is to bring Communion and pray with the sick and homebound of the parish community who are unable to attend regular liturgy due to illness or infirmity. This ministry provides the sick, homebound and/or institutionalized with a sense of community and belonging. Some of our parishioners are homebound or in nursing homes and we have a team of trained ministers who arrange to take communion to those in need. The Blessed Sacrament is the most precious gift we as Catholics can receive.
