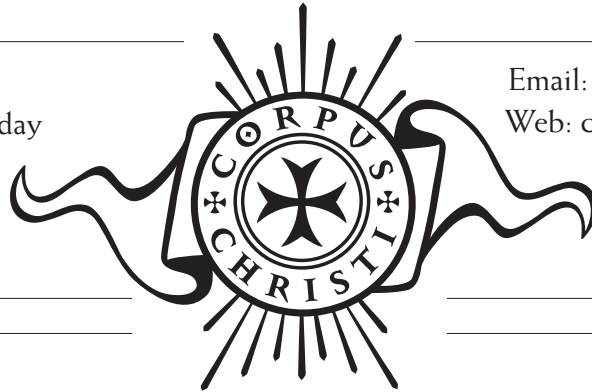

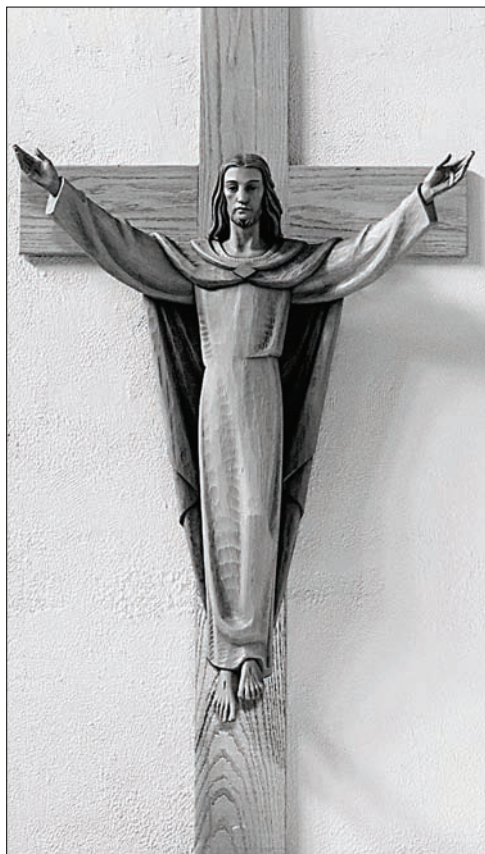

World Day for Consecrated Life - February 2
