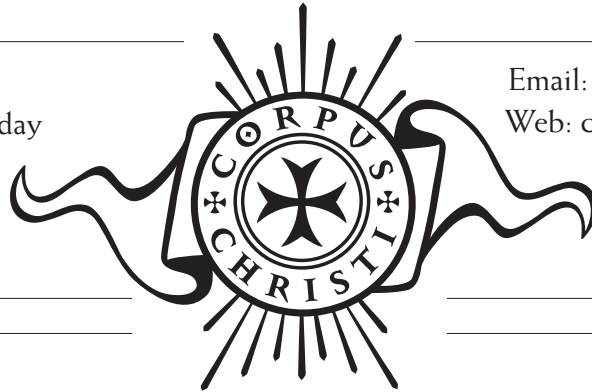

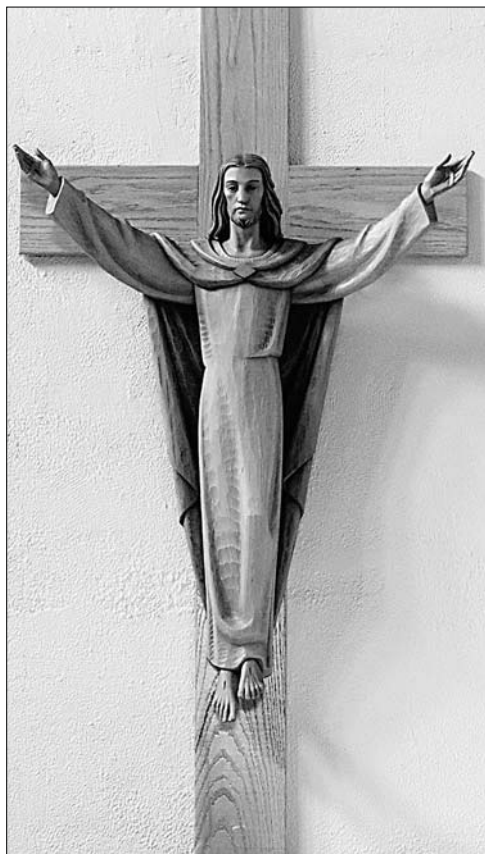

You may preregister for the Holy Week liturgies via the same link. The Way of the Cross preregister via separate link (see below).

It is good for those who are elderly and frail, or seriously ill, to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. You may contact the Parish office to book an appointment with the Pastor to receive the anointing at the office or the church, or if this is not possible it could be done at your residence.

If anyone is hospitalized and needs a priest, we are not permitted to go to the hospitals. There are dedicated Chaplains.

As we enter Holy Week, let us take some time to meditate on the radical humility of Christ crucified and seek to imitate Him in our own lives.
