Please let us know if you would like to sponsor a gift to be given to each of our Confirmation candidates.


World Communications Day – May 16

At the same time, as receivers of the materials promoted by the media, the faithful have a duty to support and promote worthwhile presentations on media and reject those which promote values contrary to spiritual growth" (ORDO, 237).
