Stewardship Reflection: 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Sirach 27.4-7 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 15.54-58 Gospel: Luke 6.39-45 – *Judging Others*

Summary

In the first reading from the book of Deuteronomy, Moses instructs the people saying that when they come to give their offerings to God, they should "bring the first of the fruit of the ground."
