



Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - Lenten Reflection for Children

A shepherd boy named David loved God so much he wrote over 150 specials prayers to God. We call these special prayers Psalms. In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium, the children reflect upon the words of Psalm 23.

(The note below is not the same reflection as the children receive in the atrium, but simply offered as an opportunity for families to have further conversation about this psalm.)

Psalm 23: 5-6

You set a table before me as my enemies watch; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Only goodness and love will pursue me all the days of my life, I will dwell in the house of the LORD for years to come.

• "Goodness" alludes to the preferential love of God. Goodness is like grace, the absolutely gratuitous love of God; it is without cause, it is given in abundance. (Ways to Nurture the Relationship with God by Sofia Cavalletti, p 40).

Procession Gospel: Lk 19.28-40 – Jesus' Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem

1st Reading: Is. 50.4-7 2nd

Reading: Phil. 2.6-11

Gospel: Lk 22.14 – 23.56 – The Passion of the Lord

Summary

It is through the crucifixion that Christ defeats Satan and triumphantly attains our salvation, allowing us to enter our heavenly home. As we approach the Holy Triduum, let us take some time each day this week to reflect on the passion of Christ. We can do this in many ways such as praying the Stations of the Cross or the sorrowful mysteries of the Rosary, reading the passion narratives in the Bible or simply gazing upon a crucifix.
