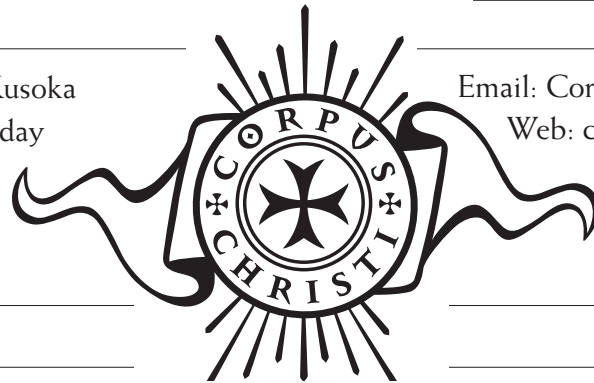

Marygrove Camp - June 11th & 12th



Marygrove Camp is a residential camp situated on Georgian Bay, near Penetang, Ontario. Open to eligible girls ages 5 - 13, Marygrove provides an 8-day camping experience for children who may not otherwise have the opportunity to enjoy a camping adventure.

Atrium Open House

The ***Catechesis of the Good Shepherd*** (CGS) is a Montessori-based program that offers children the most essential aspects of our faith, knowing that these truths will nurture their need to love and be loved and their capacity to enjoy God's presence in their life. We have three CGS environments at Corpus.

The Level 1 atrium, for 3-6 year old, which meets on Sundays from 9:00am to 10:30 am.

The Level 2 atrium, for 6-9 year old, which meets on Sundays from 9:00 am to 10:30am or on Thursdays from 5:30pm - 7:30 pm.

The Level 3 atrium, for 9-12 year old, which meets on Tuesdays from 5:00pm - 7:00 pm.

The CGS program runs with the school year. Registration opens this June for 2022-2023. Space is limited so we encourage you to register early.

We are in need of volunteers for the CGS program! Please come to our **Open House on June 5th** after the 9 am and 11 am Masses to learn more about this very rewarding ministry, and consider joining as a catechist, an assistant, or as someone willing to contribute in other ways: by helping to keep the rooms clean, doing the writing, painting, sewing, wood-working required to create our hand-made materials.

National Rosary for the Family, June 19, 2022

In preparation for the 10th World Meeting of Families (WMF), the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops' Standing Committee for Family and Life is hosting a live and nationwide Rosary for the Family via Zoom Webinar. The virtual event will take place on Sunday, June 19 at 3 p.m. and will be facilitated by several families from across the country.

As part of the Amoris Laetitia Family Year, the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network and the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life have published a "Rosary for the Family." The publication is a beautiful meditation focused on families, children, couples and grandparents. It is the hope of the Standing Committee for Family and Life that this moment will be an opportunity to gather at the national level in prayer as well as to witness alongside other faith-filled families.

Stewardship Reflection: Pentecost Sunday

1st Reading: Acts 2.1-11

2nd Reading: 1 Cor. 12.3b-7, 12-13 (or)

2nd Reading: Romans 8.8-17

Gospel: John 20.19-23 (or)

Gospel: John 14.15-16, 23b-26 – *Jesus speaks of the Holy Spirit*

Summary


As stewards, we play the important role of cooperating with the Holy Spirit to continue the work and mission of the Church. Cardinal Collins often says that the Church needs to "care for the gathered and reach out to the scattered." Let us ask ourselves how we can use our time and talents to participate in this twofold mission of the Church.

Sunday Mass Obligation

Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.

The Church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals, based on their conscience, cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, including a great vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are self-isolating to limit the spread of illness, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation, as the law of the Church allows.

After two years of COVID-19 restrictions, many have been deprived of the opportunity to attend Mass and to receive the most Holy Eucharist and all of us have missed the opportunity to experience community, including members of our parishes. As we come to the celebration of Pentecost this weekend, we invite and encourage the faithful to return to the practice of attending Mass in-person.

"PENTECOST" IS FROM THE GREEK **PENTEKOSTOS** WHICH MEANS **FIFTIETH**

We celebrate Pentecost on the 50th day after Easter.

On Pentecost, "the mission of the Christ and of the Spirit became the mission of the Church which is sent to proclaim and spread the mystery of the communion of the Holy Trinity."

After the example of Mary and the disciples on the first Pentecost on which "the Church came to birth," we pray and wait for the same Spirit graciously promised by Jesus and listen with quiet hearts to the Word of the Lord.
