

Sunday Mass Obligation

Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.

The Church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals, based on their conscience, cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, including a great vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are self-isolating to limit the spread of illness, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation, as the law of the Church allows.

After two years of COVID-19 restrictions, many have been deprived of the opportunity to attend Mass and to receive the most Holy Eucharist and all of us have missed the opportunity to experience community, including members of our parishes. As we come to the celebration of Pentecost this weekend, we invite and encourage the faithful to return to the practice of attending Mass in-person.

Have You Been Looking For a Way To Make a Difference in Our Community?



We'd love to have you as a volunteer member of the Society of St Vincent de Paul (SSVP) – Corpus Christi. There are 143 families and individuals below the poverty line that we assist.

How do we assist? In emergency, we provide food and clothing vouchers and

beds when our neighbours in need call us. Typically, 3-5 calls per week.

<u>How can you help?</u> We have multiple teams of two volunteers that take turns each month making visits, typically on Monday's. We also need someone to retrieve calls to set up the times to visit.

** Most especially, we need a volunteer with a special gift of accounting or financial background. This gift is needed to take over the role of Treasurer. Making calls/visits would not be necessary if someone wanted to just be Treasurer.

How much time do I volunteer? Typically, an hour to 1.5 hours a week plus a monthly meeting for 1-1.5 hours. We break during summer months (July-August).

Who is SSVP Globally?

The SSVP is an international organization united in the mission to serve persons in need, working to shape a more just and compassionate society. Our mission is one of direct service to persons in need of all faiths and creeds. We as members try to give those in need a sense of hope and dignity, reaching out in friendship with helping hands.

There is so much need in our community, there are people in our community • hurting and suffering • sending children to school hungry • unable to provide some basic necessities for their family • desperate • giving up hope.

Who is SSVP Locally at Corpus Christi?

Today, the Corpus Christi team consists of a small-butmighty team of five volunteer members We are looking for 1-3 more people to join. The SSVP Conference here at Corpus Christi has been operating for over 65 years.

As noted above, our volunteer efforts consist of home visits to offer assistance, an Annual Christmas Present Program, Clothing Bundle Collection Weekend and Poor Box/Special collections.

We do ALL of this through the generous donations of you, our parishioners.




Prayer to the Immaculate Heart of Mary
