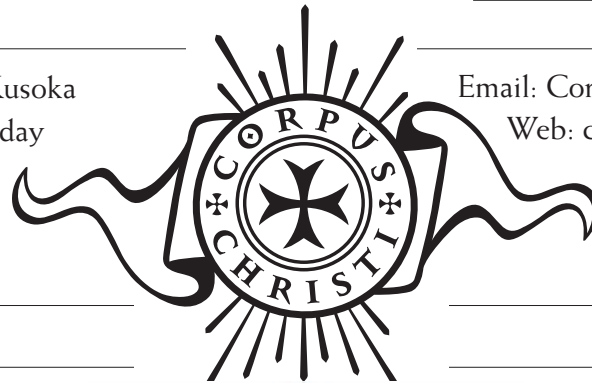

**For whom?**

2. For those who have been **baptized in a Christian church that is not Catholic**. These people would not be re-baptized (or re-confirmed); they would, however, experience the rite of being **received into full communion with the Catholic Christian Church**.
3. For those who were **baptized as Roman Catholics**, but who have **not received the Sacraments of Confirmation, the Eucharist, or Reconciliation**.
4. Those who **wish to update their understanding of their faith**.

**Stewardship Reflection:  
Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time**

1st Reading: Sirach 3.17-20, 21, 28-29

2nd Reading: Hebrews 12.18-19, 22-24a

Gospel: Luke 14.1, 7-14 – ***Humility and Hospitality***

**Summary**

The readings today remind us of the importance of humility and how God loves those who are humble of heart. In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that the humble person is one who seats himself at the lowest seat and in doing so he is exalted. As stewards, we are called to live out the virtue of humility in our lives as we share the gifts of our time and talent – keeping our hearts free from pride and remaining focused on our Lord.
