

Beyond its regular set of financial commitments, our parish currently faces some specific expenses. These include:

- replacement of the commercial dishwasher in the parish basement kitchen
- maintenance of the chairlift

Additionally, there are renovation-related loan repayment obligations to the Archdiocese that started this September.
