

All men's items will be distributed to the Good Shepherd Centre and all women's and children's items will be distributed to Rosalie Hall. The Good Shepherd Centre distributes over 100 items of clothing each day. Rosalie Hall has been serving young mothers and their children since 1914.

There is still a real need for these items especially among those who spend a great deal of their time outdoors and for new mothers raising children on their own.

Your donation of warm winter clothing will truly help those who need them the most.

Message from your Parish Council

Thank you for all the ways that you support our parish - with your presence, your engagement, your prayers.

In discussion with the Finance Committee, we wanted to take a moment to update you on some financial concerns. Beyond its regular set of financial commitments, our parish currently faces some specific expenses. These include:

- replacement of the dishwasher in the parish hall kitchen
- maintenance of the chairlift
- church repair-related loan repayment obligations to the Archdiocese

Grateful for what you already give, we ask that you please consider making additional contributions specifically to these needs if you are able. The estimate for the dishwasher is around \$3,000 - \$5,000; the chairlift needs on-going maintenance; we are re-paying the loan at a rate of \$800.00 per month.
