The Feast of Christ the King

This Feast was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI through his encyclical *Quas Primas*. The context was a rising secularism in Europe and the Roman Question (which ended with the Lateran treaty and creation of the Vatican city-state in 1929). What is striking about the encyclical is the assertion that the power of Christ the King is not rooted in violence.

The only actual crown Christ wore was a crown of thorns. By testifying to the Truth, and refraining from the exercise of earthly power that many of His followers expected, He redeemed the world.

Celebrating the feast of Christ the King is a way to assert that as Catholics we will not allow the values of our faith to be confined to the private sphere of our personal lives. The feast calls us to bring the values of our faith to bear on wider society, to raise our voices in the public realm on public affairs relating to human dignity and the common good.
