

Canada Summer Jobs Program Be Informed & Reach Out to Your MP

The federal government has introduced new requirements for employers applying for the Canada Summer Jobs grant. To be eligible for funding, employers must attest that both the job and the organization's core mandate respect certain "values" as determined by the federal government including the government's position on abortion, sexual orientation and gender identity or expression. Organizations unable or unwilling to make this attestation in whole or in part will be deemed ineligible for the grant. This requirement is clearly unjust.

Many Catholic organizations throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto and many other faiths involved in charitable activity at soup kitchens, shelters, refugee welcome centres or summer camps are impacted by this decision. EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Adoration is an act of faith and a gesture of love. Adoration is a "heart to heart" with God, a period of time presented with utter gratuity. By offering up my presence, I participate in the great offering of Jesus, that is, his life handed over "for the glory of God and salvation of the world".

I salute with a gesture of respect

I bow slowly or genuflect as a sign of respect in front of the tabernacle or before the Blessed Sacrament exposed on the altar.

I dispose my being

To put myself in a state of recollection, I choose to sit or kneel. I close my eyes or look at the host, a tangible sign of the presence of Christ.

In order to make a prayer of adoration I must be silent within myself; I must remove any sources of distractions which bother me or prevent me from letting God take over. I stop thinking of my tasks, my uncertainties, my fears, my goals of any sort.

I let go of all the concerns of the present moment to let God fill me with is love.

I am here, present, simply, freely, before the Holy Eucharistic presence; I expect nothing in return and make no particular request for anything.

I am here, happy to be here, in the name of love and in the name of the Church.

I spend time

To completely enter an attitude of offering, openness, adoration, forgetting oneself is not the work of just a few minutes; so I take the time to experience this heart-to-heart in a spirit of recollection for 20, 30 or even 60 minutes.

Prayers for Adoration

Loving Jesus,

I am filled with gratitude for the privilege of this quite time in your Presence. Grant me strength to go out from this place of sacred silence into the busy world. May my experience of your Presence here help me to see your Presence there –

In the faces of the lonely and seeking souls I meet, In the outstretched hands of the poor and needy, In the hearts of my family and dearest friends,

In the eyes of those who are most difficult and hard for me to bear.

As I experience your Presence in your beloved ones, may I act with love and generosity so that they may also experience it in me. AMEN
