She is interested in the Spiritualities of Ignatius of Loyola, Integrity of the Earth, Feminine and Native. She has ministered among the Carrier tribe in Fort St. James, B.C.

Presently she lives with her community in Toronto ministering as a Spiritual Director, having been trained for this at Ignatius Jesuit Centre in Guelph, ON.
