That rustle in the autumn breeze,

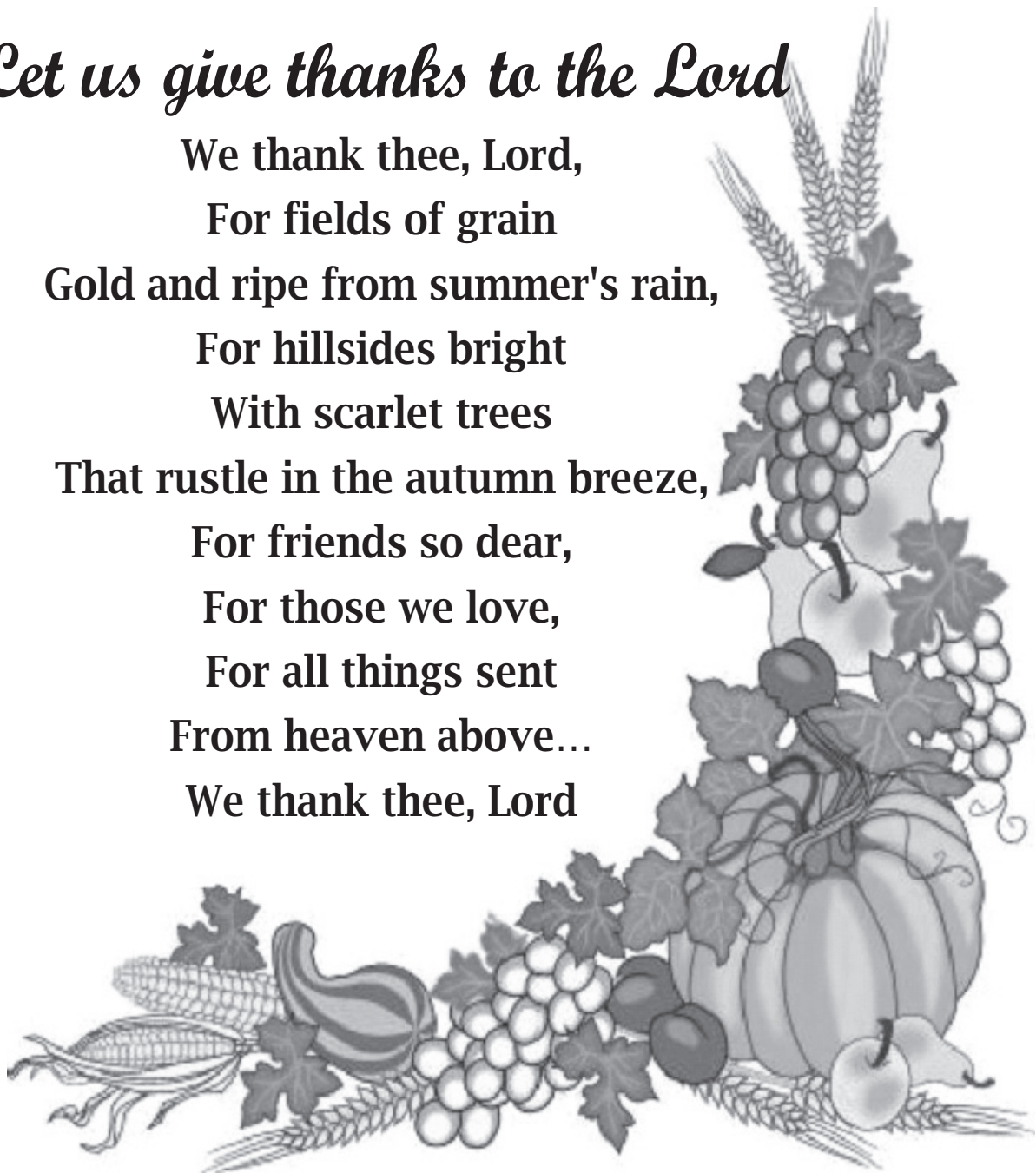

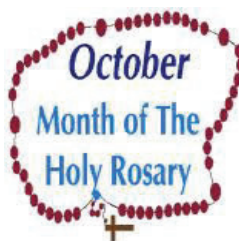
