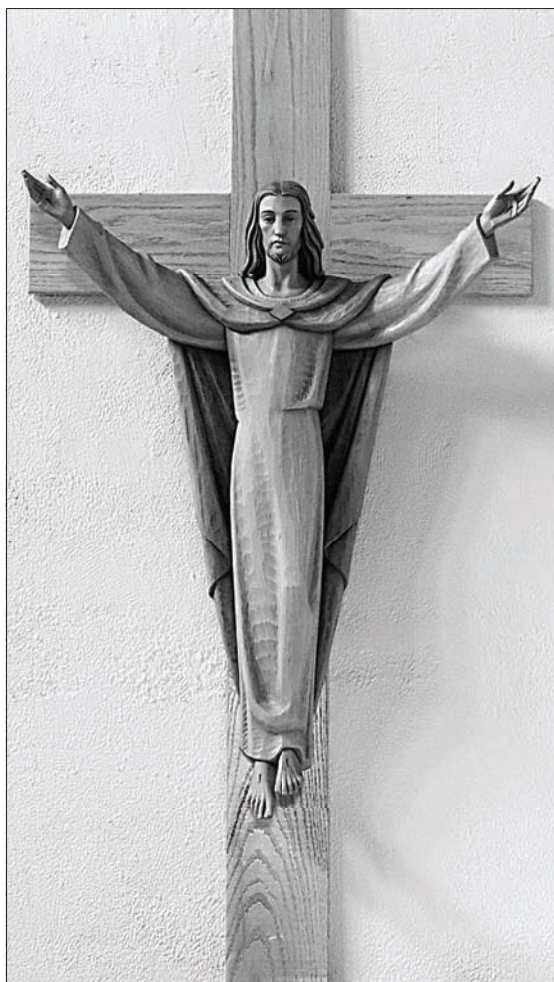

The momentum is picking up! Because of your enthusiasm and pitching in, we have received \$6,450 and it is now in the bank account; that is **43%** of the total tickets, or **1,290 tickets**. 2,700 have been taken by parishioners to be sold, so there are 1,410

tickets yet to be returned. We still have **300** tickets to be distributed and sold. We have 14 days before we wrap up for the raffle draw. The odds are 1 in 1,000 to win one of three prizes; odds are better than playing the lottery and it is for our community.

If you have some books of tickets sold, please bring them and the money to the church; you may give them to the ticket seller at the back after Mass or you can drop them off at the parish office, Tuesday to Friday, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Please bring your tickets and money by next week if at all possible. That's another 7 days to go.

We need to raise \$8,200, and printing and licencing expenses, to pay the prize winners and cover the costs. We **urgently** need your help to sell as many tickets as possible to fulfill our responsibility without taking funds from the parish. You have already shown us what you can do; we are almost there. Remember, everyone wins because it is for our parish community.
