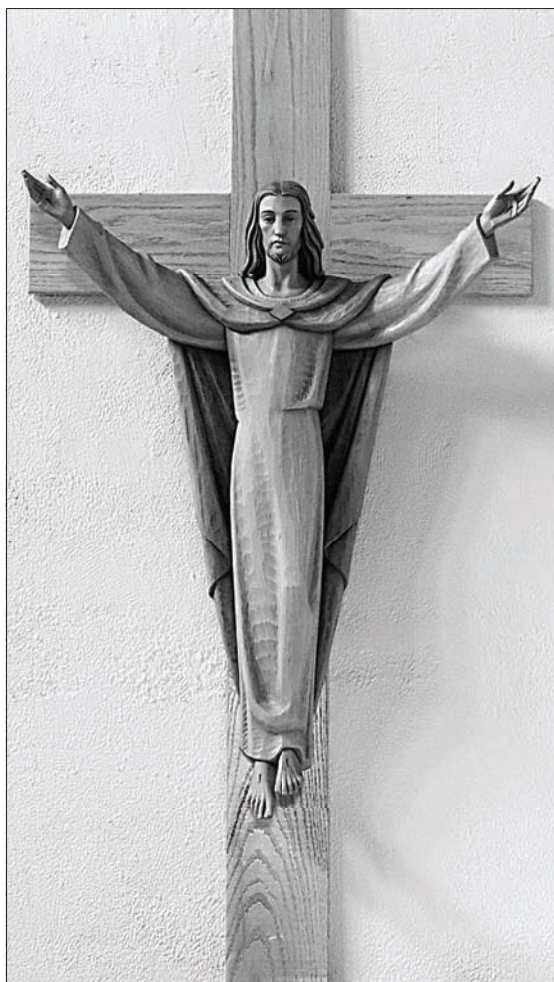

The Survival of the Amazon Concerns All Humanity
