

Ministry Recognition Weekend

As part of our parish commitment to stewardship, we will recognize one of our parish ministries on the first Sunday of each month. In two separate groups, one with primary children aged 6 and under, and another with juniors aged 7 and up, we present simple activities to encourage the children to share their ideas and experiences in practicing Jesus' teachings in their daily lives. - The Level 2 Atrium, for 6-9 year olds, which meets on Sundays from 9:00 am to 10:30am or on Thursdays from 5:30pm 7:30 pm.
- ➤ **The Level 3 Atrium**, for 9-12 year olds, which meets on Thursdays from 5:30pm 7:30 pm

The CGS program runs with the school year. Registration opens in June for 2020-2021. Space is limited so we encourage you to register early.

Because a few of our much-loved volunteers will be moving out of Toronto this summer, we are in great need of volunteers for the CGS program.
