CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

We would love to restart our Sunday Children's Liturgy at the Corpus Christi Sunday 11:00 AM Mass.

We aim to secure 4 mature, fun and engaging volunteers, who can lead and run the program on a rotating basis so it is not an overwhelming task for one person. We may have to start with one group, depending on attendance, though, ideally two groups would be created: a) one for 7-year-olds and under, and b) another for 8-years old to preteen. Four volunteers would alternate and teach only twice a month.

No prior experience is required. Materials to prepare and structure a class, as well as materials to distribute to children, will be provided. A brief lesson on how to teach liturgy with young ones is also being arranged.

Expected commitment is 1-3 hours a week: this includes printing and photocopying of materials (at the parish office if you prefer), lesson preparation, room setup, and class conduct. Each class is about 20-30 minutes long and runs from the beginning of Mass, until the collection / preparation of the gifts.

The reward for this commitment is sharing in Christ's heart for children.

If you would enjoy this type of interaction, or know of perhaps an aspiring teacher in need of volunteer hours, or a retiree seeking social engagement, please reach out to Anna and Paul via the Parish Office for more information. A police background check will be conducted.

Stewardship Reflection: The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

1st Reading: Exodus 24.3-8

2nd Reading: Hebrews 9.11-15

Gospel: Mark 14.12-16, 22-26 – *The Last Supper*

Summary

Jesus’ death on the cross is what defeated Satan and opened wide the gates of Heaven so that we who seek to follow Him can enter into that eternal rest. St. Thomas Aquinas says that “the celebration of Holy Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the cross.” Therefore, we as stewards should run to Mass as often as we can because Jesus is waiting to pour out the same love, mercy and grace that he showed on the cross.

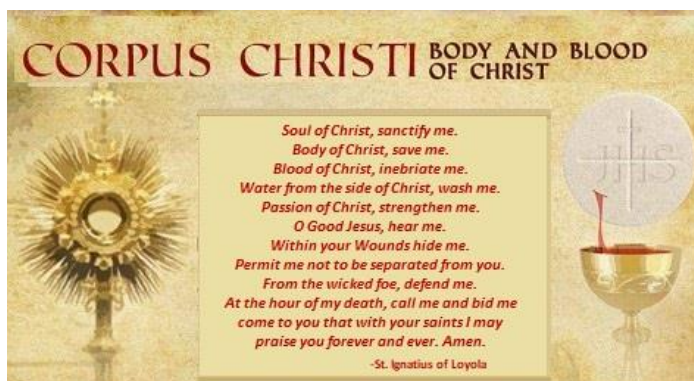
Vocation Seeds
