



Why should we Confess?

"The second precept of the Church, 'You shall confess your sins at least once a year,' ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness" (*CCC*, 2043).

Please note that the Church asks us to confess minimally, at least once a year, not only once a year. Additionally, if we do not feel sorry, and/or refuse to give up our sins we should not come to confession until there is a desire and decision to have a change of heart. But if we do desire and struggle against sin we are more than welcome to come and be forgiven.

Sunday Mass

Last Sunday I asked you to give me a feedback as to whether we could have an early Sunday Masses at 9:00 am rather than 9:30 am to give us time to greet people, avoid rush at the parking lot, and to clean the church for the next Mass at 11:00 am. You have responded in favour of the 9:00 am Mass. Thank you for completing the survey. When we resume our Sunday Masses with people, I intend to have Masses on Saturday at 5:00 pm and Sundays at 9:00 am and 11:00 am.

<u>"Virtual Mass is not a substitute for in-person Mass,"</u> is a brief and clear explanation of why it is important for parishioners actually to attend Mass when we re-open, rather than continue to participate in a virtual mass, of course, if possible, (http://bit.ly/InPersonMass).

A Fair and Just Approach to Places of Worship

You are invited to respectfully share your concerns with your local Member of Provincial Parliament (MPP) and Premier Ford regarding places of worship and Covid-19 capacity restrictions.

The province has relaxed restrictions in Grey (Lockdown) regions for retailers, allowing 25% capacity while places of worship can have no more than 10 people inside, whether they seat 100 or 1,000 people. Is this a fair and equitable approach? Visit aplacetoworship.ca today!

Anointing of the Sick

It is good for those who are elderly and frail, or seriously ill, to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. You may contact the Parish office to book an appointment with the Pastor to receive the anointing at the office or the church, or if this is not possible it could be done at your residence.

If anyone is <u>hospitalized</u> and needs a priest, we are not permitted to go to the hospitals. There are dedicated Chaplains at the hospitals. You may either contact the nurse at the hospital or call the parish office. The following standard questions will be asked and they will dispatch the on-call priest.

- 1) Name and location of the patient.
- 2) Is it for the sacrament of the sick, confession, or other? (We are not currently able to distribute Holy Communion)
- 3) Is the patient in danger of immediate death (next few hours)?
- 4) Is the patient conscious?
- 5) Is the patient's family at bedside?
- 6) We will ask for your name and contact number.

Stewardship Reflection: 4th Sunday of Lent

1st Reading: 2 Chronicles 36.14-17a, 19-23++

2nd Reading: Ephesians 2.4-10

Gospel: John 3.14-21 - Nicodemus Visits Jesus

In the first reading from 2 Chronicles we hear about how God's messengers were persecuted and despised for listening to God. As stewards, we will often also face difficulties in our ministry which is a share in the cross of Christ. To suffer for Christ is a great dignity so the next time encounter sufferings in our stewardship, let us simply pray "Lord, help me to carry this cross out of love for you."
