



Why should we Confess?

"The second precept of the Church, 'You shall confess your sins at least once a year,' ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness" (CCC, 2043).

Please note that the Church asks us to confess minimally, at least once a year, not only once a year. Additionally, if we do not feel sorry, and/or refuse to give up our sins we should not come to confession until there is a desire and decision to have a change of heart. But if we do desire and struggle against sin we are more than welcome to come and be forgiven.

Churches are Opened

On Friday March 12, the provincial government announced changes to the restrictions on places of worship currently in the Grey (Lockdown) Zone.

Effective March 15, 2021 Churches in this designation will be permitted 15% (per cent) capacity for religious services. In light of this announcement, Archbishop Cardinal Collins has asked churches to begin celebrating public Masses as soon as they are able to implement the Worship Safe health and safety protocols.

Accordingly, our Masses have resumed from Tuesday March 16th. As in the past, weekday masses will be at 9:00 am and Sunday masses will be at 5.00 pm on Saturday, and 9.00 am and 12.00 pm on Sunday.

The weekday Masses and only the 11:00 am Mass on Sunday will be both, with people, and live-streamed via our new YouTube channel, (http://bit.ly/corpuschristiyoutube). The recorded Masses will also be available at the same site.

For the purpose of contact tracing, we ask that you register via Eventbrite for one ticket for an individual, or one ticket for a family/social bubble of up to persons (https://corpuschristimasses.eventbrite.ca)

To enter the Church, please look for signs marking the proper entrance door.

The Sunday Communion Services will be discontinued effective immediately.

Anointing of the Sick

It is good for those who are elderly and frail, or seriously ill, to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. You may contact the Parish office to book an appointment with the Pastor to receive the anointing at the office or the church, or if this is not possible it could be done at your residence.

If anyone is <u>hospitalized</u> and needs a priest, we are not permitted to go to the hospitals. There are dedicated Chaplains at the hospitals. You may either contact the nurse at the hospital or call the parish office. The following standard questions will be asked and they will dispatch the on-call priest.

- 1) Name and location of the patient.
- 2) Is it for the sacrament of the sick, confession, or other? (We are not currently able to distribute Holy Communion)
- 3) Is the patient in danger of immediate death (next few hours)?
- 4) Is the patient conscious?
- 5) Is the patient's family at bedside?
- 6) We will ask for your name and contact number.

Stewardship Reflection: 5th Sunday of Lent

1st Reading: Jeremiah 31.31-34++

2nd Reading: Hebrews 5.7-9

Gospel: John 12.20-33 – Jesus Speaks about His Death

In the first reading, God tells the prophet Jeremiah, "But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people." For the Lord to insist on writing the law on our hearts, He implies that this covenant will be extremely personal and intimate. Let us strive to go to Him and bear our heart to Him, that we may be able to grow deeper in relationship with Christ.
