

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Friends, Happy Easter!

The Resurrection of Christ is an historic event; it really happened. In the Gospel, we hear that an 'angel of the Lord' appeared to the pious women and said, "Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples, 'He has been raised from the dead, and indeed he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him.' This is my message for you" (Matt 28:4-7). Jesus was dead, and they were afraid of what could happen to them as well as what happened to the Lord's body. They were also afraid because of "a great earthquake" and the presence of the angel (v. 2). Similarly, we might worry, 'what will happen to me, to us at this time of pandemic?' We might be afraid to lose our job or to get sick, even to transmit the sickness to someone else. There have been and there will always be things that will make us worry.

But Jesus has risen, and that historical event transforms our lives as well! We might feel afraid, but we are not to let the fear paralyze us. The reason for this, is that Jesus has risen! He fulfills all reality, and He is present in our reality; He is with us, 'God-with-us, Immanuel' (Matt 1:22-23)! Since He is alive, 'we may entrust all our anxieties, fears, and cares to the Lord, for He cares for us' (1 Pt 5:7). So, let us be prudent but also entrust all fears and struggles to the Risen Jesus Christ, to 'our Lord and our God,' (Jn 20:28), and see Him 'with the eyes of heart enlightened' by faith present in our reality and life (Eph 1:18).

Beloved children of God, thank you and congratulations to all who have been encountering the Lord with us at our Parish, in person or online, despite often valid fears. Thank you to all who have been serving in different ways at our church, even by your presence only. Loving service is a sign of the victory of Christ present and alive in our lives. God bless you, and Happy Easter to you and your family,

Churches are Opened

Our Masses have resumed. As in the past, <u>weekday masses</u> <u>will be at 9:00 am and Sunday masses will be at 5.00 pm on Saturday, and 9.00 am and 11.00 am on Sunday.</u>

The weekday Masses and only the 11:00 am Mass on Sunday will be both, with people, and live-streamed via our new YouTube channel, (http://bit.ly/corpuschristiyoutube). The recorded Masses will also be available at the same site.

For the purpose of contact tracing, we ask that you register via Eventbrite for one ticket for an individual, or one ticket for a family/social bubble of up to 6 persons (https://corpuschristimasses.eventbrite.ca). You may preregister for the Holy Week liturgies via the same link. The Way of the Cross preregister via separate link (see below).

To enter the Church, please look for signs marking the proper entrance door.

Sunday Mass

"Virtual Mass is not a substitute for in-person Mass," is a brief and clear explanation of why it is important for parishioners actually to attend Mass when we re-open, rather than continue to participate in a virtual mass, of course, if possible, (http://bit.ly/InPersonMass).

The dispensation from your Sunday obligation remains until further notice.

Our church will remain open daily for silent prayers Tuesday to Friday from 10:00 – 11:00 am. Preregistration is required for contact tracing (https://corpuschristitoprayers.eventbrite.ca).
