Churches are Opened

As of Friday, July 16, 2021 there will be no capacity restrictions for places of worship. However, parishioners need to maintain physical distancing of two metres (six feet) between those not from the same household.

As in the past, weekday Masses will be at 9:00 am and Sunday Masses will be at 5.00 pm on Saturday, and 9.00 am and 11.00 am on Sunday.

For the purpose of contact tracing, we ask that you register via Eventbrite for one ticket for an individual, or one ticket for a family/social bubble of up to 7 persons (<https://corpuschristimasses.eventbrite.ca>).

To enter the Church, please look for signs marking the proper entrance door.

The weekday Masses and only the 11:00 am Mass on Sunday will be both, with people, and live-streamed via our YouTube channel, (<https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCUZ7SKNksrsAmxNSJISg>). The recorded Masses will also be available at the same site.

Private Prayer

Date of the Indigenous Delegation to the Holy See

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops announced that the delegation to the Holy See to foster meaningful dialogue and healing with Indigenous Peoples and the Holy Father will take place December 17 – 20, 2021.

An excerpt of the statement reads as follows:

"Pope Francis is deeply committed to hearing directly from Indigenous Peoples, expressing his heartfelt closeness, addressing the impact of colonization and the role of the Church in the residential school system, in the hopes of responding to the suffering of Indigenous Peoples and the ongoing effects of intergenerational trauma. The Bishops of Canada are deeply appreciative of the Holy Father's spirit of openness in generously extending an invitation for personal encounters with each of the three distinct groups of delegates – First Nations, Métis and Inuit – as well as a final audience with all delegates together on 20 December 2021."
