

#### **Churches are Opened**

As of Friday, July 16, 2021 there are no capacity restrictions for places of worship. However, parishioners need to maintain physical distancing of two metres (six feet) between those not from the same household.

As in the past, <u>weekday Masses will be at 9:00 am and Sunday Masses will be at 5.00 pm on Saturday, and 9.00 am and 11.00 am on Sunday.</u>

For the purpose of contact tracing, we ask that you register via Eventbrite for one ticket for an individual, or one ticket for a family/social bubble of up to 7 persons (https://corpuschristimasses.eventbrite.ca).

To enter the Church, please look for signs marking the proper entrance door.

The weekday Masses and only the 11:00 am Mass on Sunday will be both, with people, and live-streamed via our YouTube channel, (https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCUZ7SKNksrs\_AmaxNSJIS\_g). The recorded Masses will also be available at the same site.

The dispensation from your Sunday obligation remains until further notice.




ShareLife has changed their second and third collection dates to October 2nd and October 30th respectively.


