

Stewardship Reflection: 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Jeremiah 31.7-9 2nd Reading: Hebrews 5.1-6

Gospel: Mark 10.46-52 - The Healing of Blind Bartimaeus

Summary

Today's Gospel with the blind man Bartimaeus shows us that we don't really need to have our "act together" before we begin to pray. St. Therese of Lisieux says, "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." This simple look towards Heaven is what Bartimaeus fully embodied and is what we too are called to imitate as stewards in all circumstances.

Refugee Resettlement Group update - Shihab is here!

On September 30, Shihab, a refugee from Darfur Sudan, arrived safely in Toronto after a long flight from Amman Jordan! He is extremely grateful to our parish for the warm welcome he has received and the opportunity to resettle in a peaceful country.

Thanks to some friends, we are in the process of connecting Shihab to an oncologist. We continue to search for an accommodation for a maximum of \$650.00 per month. Any help would be appreciated.

To fund our sponsorship of two of Shihab's brothers, we launched Project Sabil to raise \$36,600.00. to repay the Office for Refugees, Archdiocese of Toronto. In December 2020 we paid our first installment of \$10,000.00. Our next installment is due very soon.
