Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

The last two years have been a great trial for each one of us. Undeniably, some have suffered more than others. Yet, the Covid-19 crisis has brought the entire world to unprecedented moments of desperation, shameful segregations, loss of dear ones, loss of jobs and livelihood. Worry, fear and anxiety has often taken over and disrupted the spiritual, psycho, social and environmental aspects of our lives. In the midst of all these frightful events, God's voice assures us that our pain and struggles will never have the last word. "Do not be afraid; for see – I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, who is the Christ, the Lord. This will be a sign for you: you will find a child wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger." (Lk.2.10-12). God always shows up at the right time, in disguise yet again "forced" to use a mask. Perhaps, we are not ready to see Him unmasked.

Amid these challenges, our Christian Faith teaches us to hold on filled with hope and confident that "this, too, shall pass." Faith, hope and Love will always prevail. The Lord comes as a fulfilment of that promise. He is our "Rock and Refuge," an "Everlasting Rock" (Is. 26.4; Psalm 18.2). As Matthew Henry's Concise Commentary says, "The blessings are here put before the curses. God is slow to anger, but swift to show mercy. It is his delight to bless. It is better that we should be drawn to what is good by a child-like hope of God's favor, than that we be frightened to it by a slavish fear of his wrath" (Neh. 9.17). In today's context of and apprehension, uncertainty God's Angel announces to us, "Do not be afraid!"

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who lived in a land of deep darkness, on them light has shone... For a Child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Is. 9.2-5).

As we celebrate this Christmas 2021, I would love to express my deepest gratitude to all and each one of you dear parishioners and friends of Corpus Christi. Your faith, your courage and great generosity in keeping our parish Community re-energized are all signs of the love you have for Jesus and the affection you hold for me, your poor parish priest.

In prayer with Pope St. John Paul II, "May Mother Mary, the Virgin of expectation and fulfilment, who holds the secret of Christmas, make us all able to recognize in the Child she holds in her arms the heralded Saviour, who brings hope and peace to all. With Mary we worship Jesus and trustingly say: we need You, Redeemer of mankind, you who know the hopes and fears of our hearts. Come and stay with us, Lord! May the joy of your Nativity reach to the farthest ends of the universe!"
