### **NEW! Faith Formation Study Session 3: Friendship in Christ**



Paul reveals how he is able to joyfully share the Gospel despite his imprisonment. He echoes the Old Testament figure of Job, who also suffered despite his innocence and yet

believed in his ultimate vindication. Paul then artfully reworks the Greco-Roman ideals of friendship and citizenship, expanding the Philippians' understanding by calling them to the key virtue of humility, looking first to the interest of others in imitation of Christ. (Run time 27:34).
