





### Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - Lenten Reflection for Children

In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium, the children reflect upon the words of Psalm 23.

(The note below is not the same reflection as the children receive in the atrium, but simply offered as an opportunity for families to have further conversation about this psalm.)

#### **Psalm 23: 1-2**

*The Lord is my Shepherd, I have everything I need. In green pastures you let me graze; to safe waters you lead me;*

- When one is entrusted to such a shepherd, then one can want for nothing. The shepherd provides everything for his sheep; for their eating and drinking and rest. "Waters are especially rare and precious in so arid a land as Israel; for the shepherd to procure water for his sheep is something very great for Jewish listeners. (*Ways to Nurture the Relationship with God* by Sofia Cavalletti, p 37).

### Stewardship Reflection: 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent

1st Reading: Exodus 3.1-8a, 13-15

2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 10.1-6, 10-12

Gospel: Luke 13.1-9 – *The Need to Repent & The Barren Fig Tree*

#### **Summary**

Just as God called Moses by name at the burning bush, so too does God call each of us by name to our own particular mission of stewardship. St. Teresa of Calcutta said, "You can do what I cannot do. I can do what you cannot do. Together we can do great things." Let us reflect on how we can use our time and talents to help our parish community and readily echo the words of Moses and respond "Here I am."
