



A Message from Fr. Faustino's for Corpus Christi Feast

Today, we celebrate in the universal Church the solemn feast of Corpus Christi. At our parish level, it is a thanksgiving celebration of the 102nd Anniversary of our Church named after the Most Precious Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi. Our Mother Church established this feast for three purposes. First, to give God collective thanks for Christ's abiding presence with us in the Holy Eucharist and to honor Him there. Second, to instruct the people in the mystery, faith and devotion surrounding the Eucharist. And, third, to teach us to appreciate and make use of the great gift of the Holy Eucharist, both as a sacrament and as a sacrifice. In the three-year cycle (A.B.C.) of the Sunday liturgy, there is a different theme each year for this Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. In the first year the theme is the Eucharist as our food and drink; in the second year the emphasis is on the Eucharist as the sign of the Covenant; and in the third year the theme focuses on the priesthood of Jesus. Although we celebrate the institution of the Holy Eucharist on Holy Thursday, the Church wants to emphasize its importance by a special feast, formerly called "Corpus Christi." This is one of the few feasts left in which we observe a procession and a sung "Sequence."

Let us, therefore, thank God for our Church. Under the Covid-19 limitations we could not celebrate our Corpus Christi Parish centennial (1920-2020/22). Nonetheless, we lift our hearts to God in gratitude for our beloved Parish. Happy Anniversary to all and each member of our Parish-Community!

Sunday Mass Obligation

Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.

The Church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals, based on their conscience, cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, including a great vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are self-isolating to limit the spread of illness, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation, as the law of the Church allows.

After two years of COVID-19 restrictions, many have been deprived of the opportunity to attend Mass and to receive the most Holy Eucharist and all of us have missed the opportunity to experience community, including members of our parishes. As we come to the celebration of Pentecost this weekend, we invite and encourage the faithful to return to the practice of attending Mass in-person.

Prayer for the Second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly


I give thanks to you, Lord, For the blessing of a long life For, to those who take refuge in You, Grant always to bear fruit.
