

### **Sunday Mass Obligation**

Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.

The Church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals, based on their conscience, cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, including a great vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are self-isolating to limit the spread of illness, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation, as the law of the Church allows.

After two years of COVID-19 restrictions, many have been deprived of the opportunity to attend Mass and to receive the most Holy Eucharist and all of us have missed the opportunity to experience community, including members of our parishes. As we come to the celebration of Pentecost this weekend, we invite and encourage the faithful to return to the practice of attending Mass inperson.

#### Stewardship Reflection: Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Wisdom 18.6-9 2nd Reading: Hebrews 11.1-2, 8-19

Gospel: Luke 12.32-48 – The Faithful or the Unfaithful Slave

#### Summary

The readings today speak to us of being prepared for the coming of Jesus, who will come at a time we do not expect. When Jesus comes, he will judge us based on the way that we used the gifts that were given to us and will look at our hearts to examine where our treasure is. Let us spend some time this week examining our hearts to ensure that we are not selfish with God's gifts and to continue on our journey of becoming faithful and prudent stewards.
