

The annual event of Season of Creation begins on September 1, the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and ends on October 4, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of ecology.

# Stewardship Reflection: Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Sirach 3.17-20, 21, 28-29 2nd Reading: Hebrews 12.18-19, 22-24a

Gospel: Luke 14.1, 7-14 – *Humility and Hospitality* 

### Summary

The readings today remind us of the importance of humility and how God loves those who are humble of heart. In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that the humble person is one who seats himself at the lowest seat and in doing so he is exalted. As stewards, we are called to live out the virtue of humility in our lives as we share the gifts of our time and talent – keeping our hearts free from pride and remaining focused on our Lord.
