

### Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The <u>Catechesis of the Good Shepherd</u> (CGS) is a Montessoribased program that offers children the most essential aspects of our faith, knowing that these truths will nurture their need to love and be loved and their capacity to enjoy God's presence in their life. We have three CGS environments at Corpus.

The Level 1 atrium, for 3-6 years old, which meets on Sundays from 9:00am to 10:30 am.

The Level 2 atrium, for 6-9 years old, which meets on Sundays from 9:00 am to 10:30am or on Tuesdays from 5:00pm - 7:00 pm.

The Level 3 atrium, for 9-12 years old, which meets on Tuesdays from 5:00pm - 7:00 pm.

The CGS program runs with the school year. Registration is now open for 2023-2024.

We are excited about our Auditions and we hope that your son will join us!


