

Refugee Resettlement Group update – Ali is coming!

In September 2015, our parish established a Refugee Resettlement Group in response to a request from the Archdiocese. Since then, we have sponsored 14 refugees from 5 countries.

In 2019 we committed to sponsoring three brothers from Darfur, Sudan. While the pandemic stalled things, in September 2021, Shihab, the eldest brother arrived in Toronto. Shihab faced serious health issues diagnosed before his arrival. Family reunification became a high priority. In December 2020, we launched Project Sabil to raise the necessary funds to sponsor his two brothers. We are pleased to let you know that on July 6 we will be welcoming Shihab's brother Ali. Ali has been a refugee in Amman Jordan since 2017. Given the current civil unrest in Sudan we are happy to be able to reunite Shihab and Ali here in Toronto. Our most immediate need is to find affordable, long-term accommodation for Ali. Our small budget is \$650.00 per month. As always, thank you for your generosity. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The <u>Catechesis of the Good Shepherd</u> (CGS) is a Montessori-based program that offers children the most essential aspects of our faith, knowing that these truths will nurture their need to love and be loved and their capacity to enjoy God's presence in their life. We have three CGS environments at Corpus.

The Level 1 atrium, for 3-6 years old, which meets on Sundays from 9:00am to 10:30 am.

The Level 2 atrium, for 6-9 years old, which meets on Sundays from 9:00 am to 10:30am or on Tuesdays from 5:00pm - 7:00 pm.

The Level 3 atrium, for 9-12 years old, which meets on Tuesdays from 5:00pm - 7:00 pm.

The CGS program runs with the school year. Registration is now open for 2023-2024.
