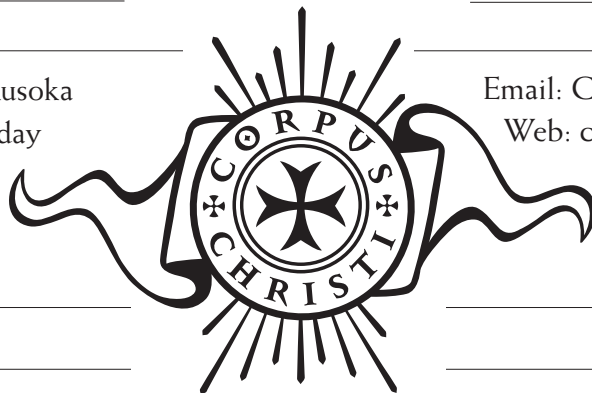

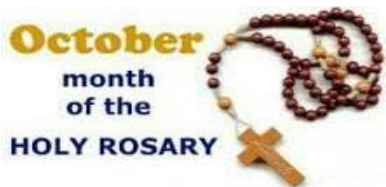
## Christmas Craft Fair
