

meet many of the faithful in a wonderful reception in the paris hall. We invite everyone to join us for a potluck high tea or dinner.

Children's Liturgy

We would love to restart our Sunday Children's Liturgy at the Corpus Christi Sunday 11:00 AM Mass.

We aim to secure 4 mature, fun and engaging volunteers, who can lead and run the program on a rotating basis so it is not an overwhelming task for one person. We may have to start with one group, depending on attendance, though, ideally two groups would be created: a) one for 7-year-olds and under, and b) another for 8-years old to preteen. Four volunteers would alternate and teach only twice a month.

No prior experience is required. Materials to prepare and structure a class, as well as materials to distribute to children, will be provided. A brief lesson on how to teach liturgy with young ones is also being arranged.

Expected commitment is 1-3 hours a week: this includes printing and photocopying of materials (at the parish office if you prefer), lesson preparation, room setup, and class conduct. Each class is about 20-30 minutes long and runs from the beginning of Mass, until the collection / preparation of the gifts.

The reward for this commitment is sharing in Christ's heart for children.

If you would enjoy this type of interaction, or know of perhaps an aspiring teacher in need of volunteer hours, or a retiree seeking social engagement, please reach out to Anna and Paul via the Parish Office for more information. A police background check will be conducted.

Stewardship Reflection: Ascension of the Lord

1st Reading: Acts 1.1-11

2nd Reading: Eph 1.17-23 or Eph 4.1-13

Gospel: Mark 16.15-20 – Jesus Commissions the Disciples

Summary

Before His ascension, Jesus tells His apostles, and us, to go into the world and spread the Gospel. To be authentic stewards we can't hang up our faith on the door as if it were a jacket we took off when we walked into the office.
