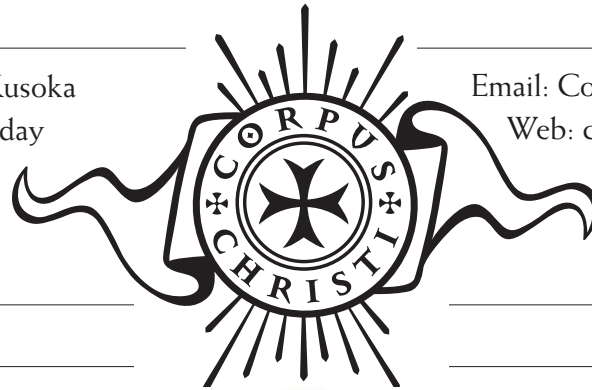

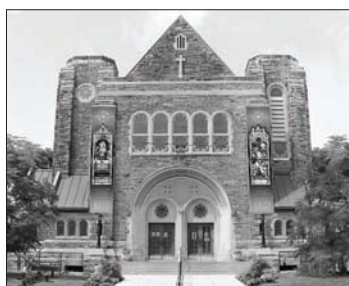

The Level 3 atrium, for 9-12 year olds: Tuesdays from 5:00pm - 7:00 pm
