Stewardship Reflection: 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Ezekiel 47: 1-2, 8-9, 12

2nd Reading: 1st Corinthians 3: 9c-11, 16-17

Gospel: John 2: 13-22 - *Destroy this sanctuary and in three days I will raise it up*

Summary

This Sunday's reading describes Jesus driving corrupt businessmen from the temple. His wrath is not because of selling sacrifices, itself, but rather the greedy focus on money with no regard to serving God. Jesus is never depicted as out of control, but His anger is clear. It's likely that this is an early temple cleansing, and the other gospels record a second, separate incident. Jesus' right to act this way is challenged by the authorities. In typical Hebrew style, they demand a miraculous sign. Jesus instead predicts His own death and resurrection. This passage contrasts with the quiet, joyous miracle at the wedding.
