NEW The donation envelopes for 2026 are available in the vestibule for pick up. They are arranged alphabetically by the last name.

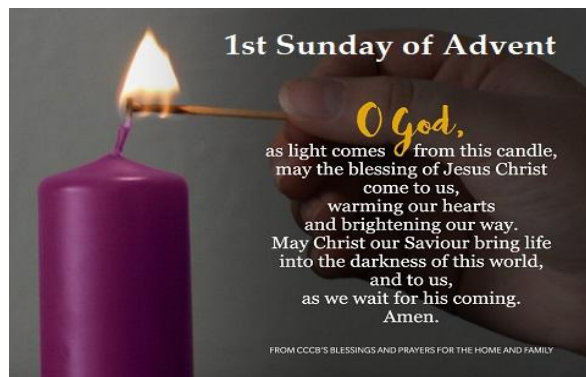
