**Lumen Gentium Forum 2026-2027**

Applications are now open for the 2026–2027 cohort of the Lumen Gentium Forum—a nine-month fellowship program for young Catholic professionals, offered by CAPP-Canada in collaboration with the Archdiocese of Toronto.

This program is designed to form Catholics **aged 25-40** for their vocations as leaders who serve the common good, share the light of Christ with others, and bring Gospel values alive in their careers, communities, families, parishes, and civic engagement. From September 2026 to May 2027, Fellows will:

- Explore an intellectually rich curriculum of magisterial documents on Catholic social teaching and virtuous leadership principles, discovering how they serve as a blueprint for building a culture of life and human dignity in our society
- Gather monthly with a community of peers for Eucharistic adoration, dinner, small-group discussion, and talks by senior Catholic leaders
- Discern, at a closing retreat, how each will “seek the kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs and by ordering them according to the plan of God” (Lumen Gentium, 31)
- Deepen their love of Christ and the Church through prayer, study, and fraternal closeness and collaboration.
