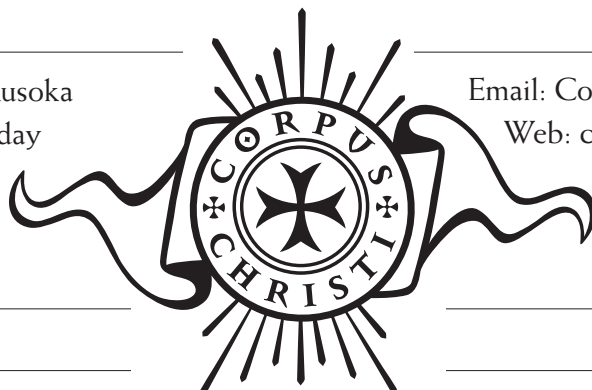

Renewing Our Parish – Corpus Christi Capital Campaign is a large undertaking to raise between \$350,000 - \$500,000 over the next 5 years. This campaign will allow us to complete urgent repairs today, as well as steward our parish responsibly for future generations. To begin the campaign and build a foundation for its success, we request that you complete a Capital Campaign pledge form as soon as possible to specify what amount you plan to donate over the next 3 to 5 years. Detailed packages with this pledge form are being mailed, and can be picked up in the church lobby, starting September 19th. We anticipate that parishioners will want to get involved or will have questions about the repairs or the campaign itself. In the coming weeks, committee members will be present in person at the back of the church. We will also be organizing a virtual Town Hall in October (dates to be announced). We encourage early feedback and questions as we embark on this initiative to renew our parish home.
